- Curriculum Alignment Project Update: we are provisionally approved!
- Expect changes to course outlines and student learning outcomes within the next year or two.
- Transitional Kindergarten Certificate and Infant/Toddler Certificate are moving through the approval pathway. Both new programs have been recommended and requested by the advisory committee due to changes in the state of California as it relates to the expansion of TK and UPK. Similar certificates at other junior colleges were reviewed, and the state recommendations for coursework were considered in the COS programs that will be moved forward for approval.
