• **Discussion:** Ms. Margaret Fernandez started the discussion by reminding the group that there was a question about the title last month, specifically the "non-degree" portion. Margaret clarified that this title is the nursing program's standard; all surrounding colleges have this degree with the non-degree portion. This is part of the accreditation standards for nursing programs, and it's basically just regular terminology to avoid burdening nursing students and forcing them to start from scratch, as if they didn't know the field, and go through all the courses.

and provide input and recommendations.


2. OC Center of Excellence

Dr. Jesse Crete, Director, Orange County Center of Excellence

• **Discussion:** Dr. Jesse create stated that they are receiving a large number of requests. Also, COE noticed that they are new faculty who are new and wanted to remind the CRLC members if you have new colleagues who will be supporting you for program recommendation. 3. OCRC Governance Structure Review

Michael Sacoto, Acting Assistant Vice Chancellor of Economic & Workforce Development/ Executive Director, OCRC



- **Discussion:** Mr. Sacoto stated that he is considering petitioning the Governance Council to place CRLC Members under Fiscal Services/OCRC Fiscal Agent Director and to add OC CEO to the resource list under SWP Regional Projects Proposal Review Committee.
- Mr. John Jaramillo asked Michael to explain what the Development Committee Proposal Development Committee does in greater detail. Mr. Sacoto responded that the group consists of Deans, Talent Development Retention Directors, K-12 Pathway Coordinators, COE, Presidents, external partners, Workforce Development Board, and external industry partners. The process by which you all collaborate with them to develop proposals and then make recommendations on which proposals should be sent to the Review Committee. Mr. Jaramillo asked if there will be a timeline for the Development Committee to work from the inception idea with the local with the college, who is submitting, or is the Development Committee going to get completed or semicompleted applications and start facilitating a discussion. Mr. Sacoto confirmed that the Development Committee is a resource and Mr. Jaramillo suggested to list the group under the resource bubble.
- Dr. Jesse Crete joined the discussion and stated that the CRLC Deans had previously decided as a region which projects would proceed to the proposal stage. The goal was to eliminate duplication and to assist in making the projects better and larger. To summarize, there was a decision-making component based on what Dr. Crete remembered from the previous year. Mr. John Jaramillo and Elizabeth Arteaga agreed with Dr. Crete comment and information that was shared. Mr. Sacoto will be reviewing the OCRC Governance Structure and update information based on today's recommendation. Lastly, Dr. Crete recommended to add the CRLC Members bubble on top with the SWP items.

III. Updates

c. District

- 1. Coastline Today Garden Grove Chamber of Commerce event was held. They had about 10 to 15 businesses attend presentations from the digital graphic design program on better ways to enhance their businesses.
- 2. Cypress They're finishing up spring outreach and re-engagement projects in an attempt to shake off Covid. In addition, they started planning for Commitment event, which is a large event with high schools. Including some auto skills challenges.
- **3.** Fullerton Dr. Cynthia Olivo, the new president. In addition, faculty attended the Temecula curriculum innovation (The Hub) event. Today is the Drone apprenticeship autonomous system event. Finally, please contact Ken if your college offers credit for prior learning language.
- **4.** Golden West
- 5. Irvine Valley
- 6. North Orange Continuing Education Had a one non-credit faculty member attend the training in Temecula. They were able to connect with Disney, and they are going do the first ever in-person Disney recruiting event at North Orange Continuing Ed for the non-credit students. It's really excited that we're getting more businesses to come in and um work with our non-credit students for employment opportunities.
- 7. Orange Coast Supporting work based learning. OCC launched a project to sort of inventory and then start to spread work based learning practices across the continuum. Also, under employer engagement initiative, OCC has launched a partnership for career mentors for students through the Mentor Collective Group. Started with the goal to recruit 50 mentors from the ranks of our advisory committee members for students, and we have exceeded that to 85 for the Fall. Question: K-16 Collaborative Grant? Mr. John Jaramillo mentioned that Kari is currently on the review stage.

- **8.** Saddleback-Today is Manufacturing Day for the Saddleback Valley Unified School District. We have about sixty high school students and some of their teachers on campus. We're trying to start building that awareness for manufacturing jobs. Also, they are hiring 27 full-time faculty.
- **9.** Santa Ana Finalized interview process for new Associate Dean. They will be starting early December, I hope this person can join us for our December meeting.
- 10. Santiago Canyon- We held a successful business and career education job fair about two weeks ago, with about fifty employers in attendance. We had several hundred students attend this job fair. They were even taking applications on the spot. In addition, SCC is looking for a new president. So, hopefully, we'll have someone in place by the start of the year. Finally, a full-time position in computer science faculty is available.
