4. Industry 4.1 Review Required Skills for Competency:	 Practice rooms may need to be properly insolated for sound. A recommendation was made to add floating floors to the rooms for better isolation. It was recommended that a Logic class be added. A suggestion was made to use smaller classrooms with the right equipment. The Board received a tour of the building. Budget and space will continue to be discussed. The area is need of people with audio engineering skills. Effort should be made to find out who the students are and what they want, as they may want to learn the skills for themselves and not to go and work for someone else. Consider looking at other colleges and recording schools to see what they offering. Steven Klein discusses the layout of a room that would work best as a recording studio.
