Re: Program review, accelerated RN AS Degree Program

Background

Butte College contacted the Far North Center of Excellence to request labor market information for development of an accelerated program to train registered nurses.

This memo provides an analysis of occupational demand and program supply data to assess labor market gaps. Data is provided for the fifteen-county Far North subregion and comes from EMSI. Occupations are aligned to career education programs using the Center of Excellence TOP-to-CIP-to-SOC crosswalk and the ONet OnLine education crosswalk. Program awards data comes from Management Information Systems (MIS) Data Mart.

Findings

What occupations are aligned to the proposed program?

- The middle-skill occupation that aligns with the proposed program modification is registered nurses (SOC 29-1141).

What are the hourly wages for the studied occupation?

- Entry-level hourly wages for this occupation exceeds the living wage of \$12.09 for a single adult in the region (Exhibit 1).

What is the employment outlook for the studied occupation?

- Overall, employment for registered nurses in the Far North is projected to grow over the next five years (Exhibit 2), with 7% projected growth.
- Between 2020 and 2025, there are projected to be 417 job openings for this occupation each year in the Far North subregion.

What does job postings data look like for the studied occupations?

- In the last 12 months (October, 2020 through September, 2021), there were 7,202 job postings for registered nurses in the Far North. Top employers and top job titles are listed in Exhibits 3 and 4.
- Registered nurse is the top occupation on the list of hard-to-fill jobs in the Far North region. Critical care nursing positions are also hard-to-fill in the Far North, with 927 postings over the last 12 months.

What does training supply look like for the studied occupation?

- Five of the seven colleges in the Far North currently offer a training program for registered nurses. Over the last three academic years, an average of 265 awards were conferred for registered nursing (Exhibit 5).

Recommendations

- Data analysis shows an undersupply of awards (n=265) compared to occupational demand (n=417) for registered nurses in the Far North.
- The Far North Center of Excellence recommends moving forward with the proposed program modification.
