

# Arboriculture Occupations Labor Market Information Report Diablo Valley College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research

December 2020

### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Arboriculture workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda, Contra Costa counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 6,109 students in the Bay region and 1,856 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.

### Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0109.10 - Landscape Design and Maintenance programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Diablo Valley College and in the region.

This report profiles Arboriculture Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for a proposed new Arboriculture Entrepreneurship program at Diablo Valley College.

First-Line Supervisors of Landscaping, Lawn Service, and Groundskeeping Workers (37-1012): Directly
supervise and coordinate activities of workers engaged in landscaping or groundskeeping activities. Work may
involve reviewing contracts to ascertain service, machine, and workforce requirements; answering inquiries from
potential customers regarding methods, material, and price ranges; and preparing estimates according to labor,
material, and machine costs.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 30%

Landscaping and Groundskeeping Workers (37-3011): Landscape or maintain grounds of property using hand
or power tools or equipment. Workers typically perform a variety of tasks, which may include any combination of
the following: sod laying, mowing, trimming, planting, watering, fertilizing, digging, raking, sprinkler installation,
and installation of mortarless segmental concrete masonry wall units. Excludes "Farmworkers and Laborers, Crop,
Nursery, and Greenhouse" (45-2092).

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: No formal educational credential

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 20%

• Tree Trimmers and Pruners (37-3013): Using sophisticated climbing and rigging techniques, cut away dead or excess branches from trees or shrubs to maintain right-of-way for roads, sidewalks, or utilities, or to improve appearance, health, and value of tree. Prune or treat trees or shrubs using handsaws, hand pruners, clippers, and power pruners. Works off the ground in the tree canopy and may use truck-mounted lifts. Excludes workers who primarily perform duties of "Pesticide Handlers, Sprayers, and Applicators, Vegetation" (37-3012) and "Landscaping and Groundskeeping Workers" (37-3011).

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 17%

# **Educational Supply**

There are seven (7) community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 70 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0109.10 - Landscape Design and Maintenance. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there are three (3) community colleges that issued 38 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

### Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 6,179 annual openings for the Arboriculture occupational cluster and 70 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 6,109 students. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 1,894 annual openings and 38 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 1,856 students.
