California and Riverside and San Bernardino Counties (Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario Metropolitan Statistical Area)

Job Opportunities

In 2016, there were nearly 85,500 medical assistants jobs in California. Just over 9% or nearly 7,900 of these job opportunities were located locally in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA in 2016. Across the local region, employment of medical assistants is expected to increase 18% through 2021, growing slightly faster than California overall growing at 15%. Employers in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA will need to hire more than 2,300 workers over the next five years to fill new jobs and to backfill jobs that workers are leaving (includes retirements).

Earnings

The average entry-level wage for medical assistants in Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA is \$10.20 per hour, below the MIT Living Wage estimate of \$12.10 per hour for a single adult living in the region. The average annual earnings for this occupation group in the region is \$30,500, assuming full-time employment. The average entry-level hourly wage in California is \$11.19 per hour.



Job Ads, Top Employers, Skills, and Education

In 2016, there were a total of 832 job advertisements (ads) for medical assistants in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA. There were 679 job ads for the same group of occupations in 2015, and 449 job ads in 2014.

The top employers posting job ads for medical assistants locally in 2016 included: Beaver Medical Group, Kaiser Permanente, and Arrowhead Orthopedics. The top worksite cities in the region were Riverside, San Bernardino, Redlands, Palm Springs, Corona, Fontana, Temecula, and Loma Linda.








Exhibit 4 lists the top specialized and soft skills that employers are seeking when looking for workers to fill medical assistant positions.



1208.00 Medical Assisting program outcomes in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA in

academic year 2013-14:

- The median annual wage after program completion is \$18,277.
- 17% of students are earning a living wage.
- Course completers reported a wage increase of 84%.
- 53% of students are employed within six months after completing a program.

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Appendix A: Occupation definitions, five-year projections, and earnings for psychiatric technician occupational group

Occupation Definitions (SOC code), Education and Training Requirement, Community College Education Attainment

Medical Assistants (31-9092)

Perform administrative and certain clinical duties under the direction of a physician. Administrative duties may include scheduling appointments, maintaining medical records, billing, and coding information for insurance purposes. Clinical duties may include taking and recording vital signs and medical histories, preparing patients for examination, drawing blood, and administering medications as directed by physician.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Postsecondary nondegree award Training Requirement: None Percentage with Community College Award or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 65%
