
Health Sector

- Health Care is considered resilient sector








San Diego County Population (2009-2019)






Imperial County Population (2009-2019)



Patient Care Coordinator Job Duties/Functions

- Meet with patients and families regarding treatments, procedures, medications, and continuing care
- Assist care team with setting goals for quality assurance best practices
- Provide community resources and referrals for continuity of care
- Assist in locating funding for special procedures or other patient needs
- Perform analytical and data entry tasks
- Answer patient calls, emails and questions, including finding insurance estimates
- Confidentially manage patient accounts
- Schedule patient visits and answer pre-visit questions, including questions about billing
- Ensure compliance with professional standards and regulatory requirements
- Provide patient consultations and recommended treatments
- Discuss cost of service, insurance coverage, and payment options with patients
- Work as a team player to ensure each patient receives the best service possible
- Schedule any necessary outpatient appointments
- Get prior authorization for procedures
- Scan documents into patient charts




Exhibit 5: Hourly Earnings of for Patient Care Coordinators in San Diego County, 2019









- Adopt/develop the Patient Care Coordinator Program
- Engage subject matter experts and faculty to assess current course content
 - Align curriculum to KSAs from employer engagement
 - Modify, expand or add courses
- Develop noncredit options
 - Especially colleges who don't currently offer MA, HHA, MS
- Consider an online program to offer flexibility for incumbent workers
