



Digital Illustration Occupations Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an “undersupply” of Digital Illustration workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region (Monterey, San Benito, Santa Cruz counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 1,127 students in the Bay region and 147 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0614.00 Digital Media programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Digital Illustration Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for a proposed new program at Cabrillo College.

Educational Supply

There are eight (8) community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 91 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0614.00 Digital Media. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is one (1) community college that issued 14 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 1,218 annual openings for the Digital Illustration occupational cluster and 91 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 1,127 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 161 annual openings and 14 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 147 students.

Occupations for this report were identified by use of skills listed in O*Net descriptions and job descriptions in Burning Glass. Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCCO Data Mart.
