

Fitness Trainers and Aerobics Instructors Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research November 2018

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Fitness Trainers and Aerobics Instructors compared to the demand for this occupation in the Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties). The gap is about 2,465 students annually in the Bay region and 373 students annually in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 0835.20 - Fitness Trainer in the state and region. It is recommended that this data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Fitness Trainers and Aerobics Instructors in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for the revision of an existing program at Cabrillo College.

• Fitness Trainers and Aerobics Instructors (SOC 39-9031): Instruct or coach groups or individuals in exercise activities. Demonstrate techniques and form, observe participants, and explain to them corrective measures necessary to improve their skills. Excludes teachers classified in 25-0000 Education, Training, and Library Occupations. Excludes "Coaches and Scouts" (27-2022) and "Athletic Trainers" (29-9091).

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 34%

There are 11 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 27 awards annually on TOP 0835.20 - Fitness Trainer. There is one college in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing two awards annually on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 2,501 annual openings for Fitness Trainers and Aerobics Instructors and 36 annual awards for an annual undersupply of 2,465 students. In the SC-Monterey sub-region, there is also a gap with 375 annual openings and 2 annual awards for an annual undersupply of 373 students.

Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCO Data Mart.
