According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics website, the mean hourly wage for a chemical technician in California is \$23.07. Of the ten metropolitan areas with the highest employment level for Chemical Technicians, two are in Southern California: Los Angeles-Long Beach-Glendale, CA Metropolitan Division (1,470 jobs) and Anaheim-Santa Ana-Irvine, CA Metropolitan Division (980 jobs). California is the state with the highest level of employment at 6,450 jobs.


The American Chemical society states that:


Employer Survey Results

When you need to fill a technical position, do you have enough well-trained applicants?





Do you have positions available for current Cerritos College students?




What training could Cerritos College offer that would benefit your current or future workers?


