Notes about occupational demand data table:

*Primary

Due to lack of data disclosed to OES (Occupational Employment Statistics and Wages, EDD LMID) and low employment figures where data is reported, the number of jobs and projections for occupations in the primary occupational cluster are understated for the Far North region. Furthermore, wage data may not be an accurate representation of earnings for some occupations. The table below displays the difference between median annual earnings for these occupations in the Far North and California.
