Behavioral Health (Certificate of Achievement)

This program will prepare students for entry-level para-professional jobs in human services by: 1) providing a historical context of the human services profession; 2) building hard and soft skill sets to include: interpersonal relationships, cultural competency/humility, active listening, case management, group process, boundary setting, self care, empathy, compassion; and 3) introducing students to fieldwork experience in human services.

This program is designed to provide entry-level skills to work in human service positions and/or provide an applied foundation for further education in a variety of areas, including (but not limited to) counseling, psychology, social work, social justice work, and health care.
