Introduction

This report provides an overview of the labor market demand and community college supply for occupations related to horticulture.

The data in this report provides an overview of the employment demand, wages, real-time job postings, and an analysis of related, existing community college program awards and student data across North/Far North subregions: the 7-county North and the 15-county Far North.

Key findings include:

- North region horticulture jobs are projected to grow by 5.3%, adding 1,214 jobs over the next five years.
- Horticulture jobs are projected to have 3,266 annual openings over the next five years.
- Median hourly wages are above the living wage threshold for a one-adult household in the North (Greater Sacramento) region.
- Existing workers in related occupations typically hold a high school diploma or less. The typical entry-level education for the selected occupations is, at most, a high school diploma.
- Regional community colleges conferred an average of 50 awards per year over the last three years.



Occupational Demand

Four Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) codes were analyzed concerning the proposed program. Exhibit 1 summarizes job trends for the selected SOC codes in Greater Sacramento, the Far North, and California.



Exhibit 2 shows the percentage change in the number of jobs between 2007 through 2018 and occupational projections from 2018 through 2023. The rate of change is indexed to the total number of jobs in 2007 as the base year and compares Greater Sacramento, the Far North, and California.




Exhibit 2: Rate of change for selected occupations



Occupational Wages

Exhibit 3 displays the median hourly wages for selected occupations in the study regions compared to the median living wage for a one-adult household in the Greater Sacramento (North) region.

Job Postings

This section summarizes job postings data for the North/Far North region. Jobs postings come from Burning Glass Labor Insights, a real-time, online, labor market information tool. Burning Glass identified 987 online job listings in the 22-county North/Far North region, from February 1, 2019, to January 31, 2020.

Exhibit 4 shows the top job titles for advertised positions in related job postings. All 987 job postings included a job title.

Exhibit 7 shows the top skills listed in related job postings in the study region. Sixty-six percent (n=650) of the job postings included at least three skills in the advertisement.



Exhibit 8: Top locations, by county, in related job postings






Educational Attainment

Related Program Awards

Exhibit 9 shows the 3-year average number of community college certificates and degrees conferred in selected programs. The programs analyzed include the following:

- Horticulture (0109.00)
- Landscape Design and Maintenance (0109.10)

In the last three years, the community colleges conferred an average of 50 awards.

Exhibit 9: Three-year average certificates and degrees awarded in the North/Far North (15 colleges) region, 2016-2019







Exhibit 10 displays detailed program data for the average number of certificates and degrees awarded in the most recent three academic years.

Findings

- Horticulture jobs grew by 5% in the North (Greater Sacramento) region over the last ten years. Horticulture jobs are projected to grow by 5.3%, adding 1,214 jobs over the next five years.
- Horticulture jobs are projected to have 3,266 annual openings over the next five years.
- Median hourly wages are above the living wage threshold for a one-adult household in the North (Greater Sacramento) region. Median wages range from \$12 per hour to \$18 per hour for the occupations studied.
- Existing workers in related occupations typically hold a high school diploma or less. The typical entry-level education for the selected occupations is, at most, a high school diploma.
- Regional community colleges conferred an average of 50 awards per year over the last three years.



Recommendations

- There will be an estimated 3,266 annual openings for horticulture jobs through 2023. The number of related awards on average from the region's community colleges is 50.
- Simple gap analysis indicates that there is significant demand for the studied occupations.
- The COE recommends moving forward with the program.
