The San Diego City College Photography program is in the process of updating a few courses, certificates, and our associate's degree with an effective date of Fall 2022.

The San Diego City College Photography program provided an overview of curriculum changes that will benefit the students due to the following:

- Streamlining course sequence in photographic lighting courses:
 - PHOT 200A - Photographic Lighting: 2-year review; Correct unit load to 3-units (2.0 lecture/1.0 lab) as course content does not require 4.0 units; Remove PHOT 143 prerequisite; Add PHOT 143 advisory; Propose for emergency DE.
 - PHOT 200B - Intermediate Photographic Lighting: 2-year review; Correct TOP Code to 1012.00; Revise course number from 203 to 200B - this is the second course in a series of lighting techniques; Add PHOT 203 course equivalency and limitation on enrollment; Update discipline; Change unit load to from 4 units to 3 units (2.0 lecture, 1.0 lab); Propose for emergency DE.
- Deactivating course:
 - PHOT 240 - Large Format Photography: Course no longer offered at City College.
- Revising program awards in response to curriculum changes and resulting to more completers:
 - Total unit changes due to 200A/B reduction from 4 units to 3 and deactivation of PHOT 240 effects the following awards:
 - Photography, Associate of Arts Degree: 42 to 41 Units
 - Certificate of Achievement in Photography: 42 to 41 Units
 - Certificate of Achievement in Freelance Photography: 24 to 23 Units
