Recommendation

Based on all available data included in this report, it is recommended that Skyline College pursue this new program area. The demand for this occupation is based on 98 online jobs postings in the latest 12-month period in the Bay region compared to no supply, since currently no community college in the region has a program for Anesthesia Technology.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for the only community college program in the state educating Anesthesiologist Assistants, which is at Pasadena City College. It is recommended that this data be reviewed to better understand how this college's student outcomes could be used as a benchmark for the new program at Skyline College.

Introduction

This report profiles Anesthesiologist Assistants in the 12 county Bay Region and the Mid-Peninsula Sub-Region (San Francisco and San Mateo counties) for a new Anesthesia Technology program at Skyline College.

Anesthesiologist Assistants (SOC 29-1071.01): Assist anesthesiologists in the administration of anesthesia for surgical and non-surgical procedures. Monitor patient status and provide patient care during surgical treatment.

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 39%

Note: Labor market information from EMSI is not available at the eight-digit level for SOC codes, however it is possible to get job postings information at the eight-digit level from Burning Glass.

Educational Supply

A TOP code does not exist for Anesthesiologist Assistant in the TOP code system. The new program request for LMI information referenced a program on 1201.00 Health Occupations, General, at Pasadena City College. There is one program issuing awards in the Bay Region on that TOP code at Contra Costa; however, it does not appear to be related.

There is a clear CIP code for this program area 51.0809 Anesthesiologist Assistant. However, there are no awards issued on that CIP code in California for 2013-16 based on a search in IPEDS.

The information contained in Table 6 and in the Student Outcomes section following are for the program at Pasadena City College since that appears to be the only program in the state issuing two-year degrees or certificates for Anesthesiologist Assistants.

Student Outcomes

Based on the information available in the CTE Launchboard, students taking courses at Pasadena City College on the TOP code for their Anesthesiologist Assistant program are doing very well compared to students in the Health sector in the Bay Region.

1201.00 Health Occupations, General at Pasadena City College:

- 77% of students were making a living wage after the coursework at Pasadena City College on 1201.00 in 2014-15 and 92% in 2013-14. In the Bay Region, the percent of students earning a living wage in 2014-15 in the Health sector was 50% in 2014-15 and 46% in 2013-14.
- 85% of students were employed four quarters after exit in 2014-15 and 100% in 2013-14. The median for the Health Sector in the Bay Region was 74% in 2013-14 and 2014-15.
- Median earnings in the second quarter after exit was \$15,160 in 2014-15 and \$12,730 in 2013-14. Median earnings for students in the Health sector in the Bay region was \$9,000 in 2014-15 and \$8,000 in 2013-14.

Skill & Certifications

Table 7 provides the top skills and certifications that appear to be frequently listed in the job advertisements for Anesthesiologist Assistants over the latest 12-month period.

Occupations for this report were identified by use of skills listed in O*Net descriptions and job descriptions in Burning Glass. Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCCO Data Mart.
