1. Purpose of the Advisory Committee Meeting

A. POST states: Each College Academy shall institute an advisory committee of Law enforcement officials to assist in providing logistical support and validation of training.

8. Modern Policing Degree
 - A. AB89 Taskforce Recommendations: 1. Establish a modern policing degree that prepares students for a career as a peace officer, completed prior to obtaining a POST certificate or 24 months after being hired. 2. Colleges currently operating a POST certificate academy adopt the modern policing degree curriculum. 3. The CCC should develop the modern policing degree with Transferability into a baccalaureate degree in mind. 4. The CCC should develop a baccalaureate degree in policing.
 - B. Legislative Update: Trailer Bill to move through the budget process conversations include: Changing “and” to “or”, Extended to 2028 or 2029, little will be known until the May revise. Senate Bill 1122: Changes “and” to “or”, allow up to 36 months to complete degree, No change to the implementation date: 2025.
 - C. Modern Policing Degree Work Group: Comprised of Administration of Justice & Academy staff. Begin meeting in February, discussed charge and tight timeline, began identifying courses and what is currently being offered, began building skeleton for coursework.
 - D. Timeline: Need to use current legislative language, purpose model degree by mid may, meet with CCCCO, roll out to colleges as soon as possible, Colleges should complete pre-work, begin approval process, implementation checklist,
 - E. What’s next? Follow up meetings and posted on websites.
