Overview of Partnership

The Committee reviewed a request from the Fresno, Madera, Kings, and Tulare Building Trades Council (FMKT BTC) to Fresno City College (FCC) for curriculum partnership of the Valley Build Pre-Apprenticeship program called Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3).

Having thoroughly reviewed the breadth and scope of MC3's curriculum, Fresno City College (FCC) presented 2 courses, 1 non-credit certificate, and 2 for-credit non-transferable certificates with intention to submit to the CCCCO system approval in Fall 2024. This curriculum is subject to change pending the final approval outcome.

Action by Committee

1. State Center Community College District and Fresno City College administration to confirm that the necessary resources and funding are authorized and allocated to Fresno City College for appropriate support of this partnership in the start-up phase and then for ongoing needs.
2. FCC to submit curriculum to CCCCCO for approval Fall 2024.
3. The Committee to explore high school dual enrollment at a subsequent Committee meeting.
