##### Preschool-Third Grade Credential

- CDEV 298A/B will count towards teaching credential program

- Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) has expressed an interest in SAC patterning with them. They are creating a Bachelor's Degree and P-3 Teaching Credential

#### Adding AA-T: Child and Adolescent Development

- Students who are interested in studying a general overview of Child and Adolescent Development while pursuing coursework that will prepare students to transfer to a university to earn a bachelor's degree in Child and Adolescent Development or a related field.
- This degree would be ideal for students who want to study human development - or a supplement to another discipline (sociology, psychology, medicine) - individuals working with families and children that have pursued a different degree, etc.
- "The focus of this Child and Adolescent Development TMC is to give students *who may not be interested* in a curricular or classroom focus an opportunity to transfer and pursue another specialty. This TMC was designed *specifically* as an alternative choice for students interested in the interdisciplinary field of Child and Adolescent development. An Early Childhood TMC is already available for students interested in preschool teaching and receiving their Child Development Teaching Permit."
- Add Family and Community Education emphasis: Students planning to work with children, adults, and their families. This may include careers in child life, counseling, home visitation programs, human services, mental health, recreation, school psychology, social work, or related fields. Students will pursue coursework to enhance their pre professional background that will prepare students to transfer to a university to earn a bachelor's degree.
