IV. Pending Proposals (Status)

Ornamental Horticulture Certificate
Landscape Horticulture Certificate

Both proposals are ready for submission to the State. They were supported by the NS Division, received recommendation from the OCRC, and have been approved by the Fullerton College Curriculum Committee, and NOCCCD DCCC and Board of Trustees. They will become effective fall 2025.

V. Required Revisions

Although these programs were previously approved by the State, record of previous approval by OCRC (formerly LAOCRC) could not be found. As such, resubmission to the OCRC is required. Applications will be created and submission for recommendation will be made. At the moment, proposals in

CNET exists with revision narratives and labor market information (LMI) attached to each.

Greenhouse and Nursery Production Certificate **MSU**

The CNET proposal consists of a title revision (HORT 164 F) and a course addition (HORT 255 F). HORT 255 F was important for the program because it is all done in the greenhouse and it is one of the newer production technologies that should be included in this certificate.

Landscape Design/Management Certificate **MSU**

The CNET proposal consist of multiple revisions, including movement of HORT 165 F and HORT 200 F to the required courses (section) and movement of HORT 153 F and HORT 177 F to a restricted electives category (B). This change represents an attempt to better match the required coursework with the premise of certificate: landscape design and management. Aside from additional title revisions, this program revision includes the addition of HORT 250 F Permaculture Design, as this design course was not included in the certificate previously.

Pest Management Certificate **MSU**

The CNET proposal consist of multiple title revisions (HORT 046 F, 160 F, 161 F, and 188 F), removing the use of abbreviations and punctuations (as requested by the Fullerton College Curriculum Committee), and the removal of HORT 215 F. Additionally, this revision includes the addition of two drone courses from the relatively new drone program: TECH 140 F Basic Drone Maintenance and Repair and TECH 151 F Applied Drone Piloting.
