a. Proposed Change: Create a new course PHOTO 21 Event Photography

- i. Reason: Event Photography is an in-demand field that is not adequately covered in other courses.
- ii. Decision: The consensus is that this is a beneficial and much-needed course for the program. A vote was initiated to accept the proposed change.

- v. Decision: The consensus is that these courses are relevant to the commercial photography industry and should be added to the certificate. A vote was initiated to accept the proposed change.

d. Proposed Change: Create Commercial Photography A.S.

i. Reason: The Commercial Photography Certificate has enough credits to become a degree and it is an in-demand field.

- ii. Possible issue: Will a second degree decrease enrollment from courses that are in the Professional Photography A.S. (PHOTO 15, 18, 45, 49)
- iii. Notes: The committee decided to table this until a later date.

- e. Guidance Needed: PHOTO 49 Multimedia Photojournalism
 - i. Reason:
 - 1. This course has failed to meet the minimum enrollment requirements for the last 3 years. Due to COVID and student petitions, it has been allowed to run in 2022 and 2023. It was canceled for 2024.
 - 2. It is part of the Professional Photography A.S. Degree. The 2024 cancellation has left students unable to obtain their A.S. degree.
 - 3. The Photojournalism C.A. is the lowest-performing C.A. with only one being awarded in the last 4 years.
 - 4. JOURN 14 Multimedia Reporting covers similar material, are students who are interested in photojournalism getting a Journalism Degree instead?
 - ii. Possible Solutions:
 - 1. Add PHOTO 49 to Professional Photography C.A. and hope it increases enrollment.
 - 2. Replace PHOTO 49 with JOURN 14 in our C.A.
 - 3. Remove PHOTO 49 and Photojournalism C.A.
 - 4. Other option?
 - iii. Notes: Diana Baldrica read the JOURN 14 syllabus and found that its emphasis was more on writing (reporting) versus photo/video/audio (visual documentation), therefore, it does not cover the same material.
 - iv. Decision: The consensus is that this course is vital to the program and that the below actions be taken. A vote was initiated to accept the following course of action:
 - 1. Change the course name to PHOTO 49 Documentary Media to be more accessible to students.
 - 2. Add PHOTO 49 to the Professional Photography C.A.
 - 3. Create a marketing campaign to increase enrollment.
 - 4. Discuss adding courses to the C.A. at the next advisory meeting.
