The Inland Empire/Desert Regional Consortium is comprised of the 12 community colleges in Riverside and San Bernardino counties. The California Community College Chancellor's Office requires that all requests for new CTE program approvals include a recommendation from the "appropriate CTE Regional Consortium" (PCAH 7th Edition, page 22). This recommendation ensures program offerings meet regional labor market needs and do not unnecessarily duplicate programs.

 - Updates from the July 14, Mapping Summit ([link](#) to project)
 - The summit was to hear from those that are using the map and to see how to improve it.
 - The map is receiving 19,000 views a week.
 - The current map will be updated by the end of November.
 - We are working on “Map 2.0”. The goal is to keep all the stakeholders in mind. The goal is to have it completed by early 2023.
 - Gather feedback/ ideas on groups we may want to add to this project
 - Here’s Michael’s “ask”:
 - Can we add the satellite campuses to the colleges?
 - Can we add the information where the program is actually being offered?
As of now it shows all programs are being offered at the main campus.
(Example using MSJC - the course is held at a satellite campus. However the course will show being held at San Jacinto when the program is actually being held at Menifee).
 - Can we have a single point of contact at the college?
